RE: **Request for a 60-Day Extension**

The West Maui Community Plan Advisory Committee (CPAC) has been meeting to prepare the update to the West Maui Community Plan. The first meeting was held on July 25, 2019 and since then the CPAC has held 18 meetings with seven more scheduled. The deadline for the CPAC, according to MCC 2.80B, is January 20, 2020.

Looking at the schedule, see attached, the CPAC will need additional time to review the Growth Framework for the Urban Growth Boundaries as well as conduct a final review of the Goal, Policies, and Action statements. Additionally, the schedule contains several holiday breaks including Thanksgiving, Christmas, New Year, and Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day. All of those breaks mean that not only is the support of staff unavailable, but members of our committee are traveling and it will be difficult to achieve productive discussions and probably even quorum. Therefore, the CPAC requests an additional sixty days to complete the update to the West Maui Community Plan.
